INTRODUCTION TO UNHCR

The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) was established on December 14, 1950 by the United Nations General Assembly. The agency is mandated to lead and co-ordinate international action to protect refugees and resolve refugee problems worldwide. Its primary purpose is to safeguard the rights and well-being of refugees. It also has a mandate to help stateless people.

In more than six decades, the agency has helped tens of millions of people restart their lives. Today, a staff of some 6,600 people in more than 110 countries continues to help about 34 million persons. To help and protect some of the world's most vulnerable people in so many places and types of environment, UNHCR must purchase goods and services worldwide. 1. REQUIREMENTS

The Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR), Sudan, invites qualified suppliers to make a firm offer for the supply of IT Equipment for UNHCR Operation in Sudan.

IMPORTANT:

Exact technical specifications of the items are detailed in **Annex A – Technical Specifications** of this document.

UNHCR may split the award between more than one bidder. The successful bidder/s will be requested to maintain their quoted price model for the duration of the delivery.

The required quantities for each item are specified on **Annex C – Financial Offer Form**.

IMPORTANT:

The initiation of conciliation or arbitral proceedings in accordance with **article 19** "settlement of disputes" of the UNHCR General Conditions of Contracts for provision of Goods and Services shall not be deemed to be a "cause" for or otherwise to be in itself a termination clause.

It is strongly recommended that this Invitation to Bid document and its annexes be read thoroughly. Failure to observe the procedures laid out therein may result in disqualification from the evaluation process.



Note: this document is not construed in any way as an offer to contract with your firm.

Bidders are required to submit any request for clarification in respect of this ITB by e-mail to Ms. Sarra Khalil - Senior Supply Associate both at KHALILSA@unhcr.org and at SUDKH-SU@unhcr.org. **The deadline for receipt of questions is 23:59 HRS LOCAL TIME on 29th OCTOBER 2023.**

IMPORTANT:

Please note that Bid Submissions are **not** to be sent to the e-mail addresses above. Failure to comply with this provision may result in disqualification.

UNHCR will reply to the questions received as soon as possible by means of publication on its website, UNGM, or by email to all bidders who will confirm their participation.

2.4 YOUR OFFER

Your offer shall be prepared in English.

Please submit your offer using the Annexes provided. Offers not conforming to the requested formats may be not taken into consideration.

IMPORTANT:

Inclusion of copies of your offer with any correspondence sent directly to the attention of the responsible buyer or any other UNHCR staff other than the submission e-mail address will result in



disqualification of the offer. Please send your bid directly and only to the address provided in the "Submission of Bid" section 2.6) of this ITB.

Your offer shall comprise the following two sets of documents:

- Technical offer
- Financial offer

2.4.1 Content of the TECHNICAL OFFER

IMPORTANT:

No pricing information should be included in the Technical offer. Failure to comply may risk disqualification. The technical offer should contain all information required.

The technical details of the products requested by UNHCR can be found in **Annex A – Technical Specifications**.

Your technical offer should clearly state whether or not the goods you are offering are fully conforming to the product specifications given. Clearly state and disclose any discrepancies with the specifications given.

The following details shall also be provided in the Technical Offer.

Incoterms: The International Chamber of Commerce Incoterms 2010 shall apply for this ITB and for any resulting purchase orders(s) – **DAP UNHCR Office in Port Sudan**.

Packaging and Batches details: The technical offer shall clearly indicate the acceptance of the required packing/packaging in compliance with the packing/packaging of batches required in **Annex A – Technical Specifications** to this ITB.

Delivery Capacity: The bidder shall state the mobilization time, ex-stock quantity and quantities available, and shall indicate the soonest proposed deliver schedule for the Eight batches as listed in details in the attached **Annex A – Technical Specifications**.

Inspection: Inspection of goods will be applicable and will be advised at the time of purchase/delivery. The inspection will be arranged by UNHCR concerned colleagues/technicians.

Batch and Supplier Identification Marks: The successful bidders will be expected to affix non-removable and permanent marking on each individual item clearly identifying the production batch and the supplier. Your technical offer should contain the details on how you would implement such markings (as indicated in the technical specifications of the products found in **Annex A – Technical Specifications**).

Country of Origin of the Supplier and place of Manufacture:

The technical offer shall state the country in which the supplier is registered as well as the country and place of manufacture of the products – **Only suppliers who are locally registered in Sudan are allowed to participate**.

Warranty: The bid shall include defects and liability period with terms of warranty.

Certificate: If available, the bidder shall submit a copy of internationally recognized quality certificate of the manufacturing company together with a copy of quality certificate for the finished product.



Vendor Registration Form: If your company is not already registered with UNHCR, you should complete, sign and submit with your technical proposal the Vendor Registration Form - Annex D.

If your company is already registered with UNHCR, please submit an empty Vendor Registration Form clearly indicating your UNHCR Vendor ID.

UNHCR General Conditions for Provision of Goods and Services: Your technical offer should contain your acknowledgement of the UNHCR General Conditions for Provision of Goods and Services by signing - Annex E.

Please note that submitting an offer is deemed as acceptance of UNHCR's General Conditions for Provision of Goods and Services.

2.4.2 Content of the FINANCIAL OFFER

Your separate **Financial offer** must contain an overall offer in US Dollars.

The prices offered should remain valid for at least **Six months**.

The Financial offer is to be submitted as per the Financial Offer Form - Annex C. Bids that have a different price structure may not be accepted.

The following details shall be provided for each item:

Unit costs: The bidder shall quote the unit price DAP UNHCR Office in Port Sudan. The unit cost shall be provided for the supply of product in Batches.

UNHCR is exempt from all direct taxes and customs duties. With this regard, price has to be given without VAT.

You are requested to hold your offer valid for **180** days from the deadline for submission. UNHCR will make its best effort to select a company within this period. UNHCR's standard payment terms are within 30 days after satisfactory implementation and receipt of documents in order.

The cost of preparing a bid and of negotiating a contract, including any related travel, is not reimbursable nor can it be included as a direct cost of the assignment.

2.5 BID EVALUATION:

2.5.1 **Supplier Registration:**

The qualified suppliers will be added to the Vendor Database after investigation of suitability based on the submitted Vendor Registration Form and supporting documents. The investigation involves consideration of several factors such as:

- Financial standing,
- Core business,
- Track record,
- Contract capacity.

This will be followed later by performance evaluation as a supplier such as:

- Random / periodic testing of the supplier's products,
- Ability to respond quickly to Agency's needs,
- Timely delivery,



- Dependability of products and services.
- Lead time for delivery

2.5.2 Technical evaluation:

The technical component of the submission will be evaluated using the criteria **PASS or FAIL by using the exact same structure as outlined in Annex B – Technical Offer Form and based on the requirements from Annex A – Technical Specifications.**

2.5.3 Financial evaluation:

The financial component will be analyzed only for those suppliers that pass the technical evaluation.

All bids from pre-qualified suppliers will be evaluated based on:

- Compliance with the established UNHCR specifications,
- Unit cost DAP,
- Delivery capacity

For evaluation purposes only, the offers submitted in currency other than US Dollars will be converted into US Dollars using the United Nations rate of exchange in effect on the date the submissions are due.

UN Global Compact and other factors: UNHCR supports the UN Global Compact Initiative put forward on 31 January 1999 by UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan that would bring companies together with UN agencies, labor and civil society to support ten principles in the areas of the human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. We encourage our suppliers to sign up with the UN Global Compact Initiative.

2.6 SUBMISSION OF BID:

The offers must bear your official letter head, clearly identifying your company.

Bids should be submitted **by e-mail** and all attachments should be in PDF format. (Copies of the PDF format documents may, as an addition, be included in Excel or other formats etc.).

The Technical and Financial offers shall be clearly separated.

IMPORTANT:

The technical offer and financial offer are to be sent in separate documents. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.

Deadline: 30th October 2023, 23:59 hrs local time.

IMPORTANT:

Any bid received after this date or sent to another UNHCR address may be rejected. UNHCR may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids, by notifying all prospective bidders simultaneously.

It is your responsibility to verify that all e-mails/documents have been received properly before the deadline. Please be aware of the fact that the e-mail policy employed by UNHCR limits the size of attachments to a maximum of **20 Mb** so it may be necessary to send more than one e-mail for the whole submission.

UNHCR will not be responsible for locating or securing any information that is not identified in the bid. Accordingly, to ensure that sufficient information is available, the bidder shall furnish, as part of the bid, any descriptive material such as extracts, descriptions, and other necessary information it deems would enhance the comprehension of its offer.

IMPORTANT:

The Financial offer will only be opened for evaluation if the supplier's technical part of the offer has passed the test and has been accepted by UNHCR as meeting the technical specifications.

2.7 BID ACCEPTANCE:

UNHCR reserves the right to accept the whole or part of your bid, or to allow split or partial awards.

UNHCR may at its discretion increase or decrease the proposed content when awarding the contract and would not expect a significant variation of the rate submitted. Any such increase



or decrease in the contract duration would be negotiated with the successful bidder as part of the finalization of the Purchase Orders for Goods.

UNHCR may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids, by notifying all prospective suppliers in writing. The extension of the deadline may accompany a modification of the solicitation documents prepared by UNHCR at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective supplier.


Please note that UNHCR is not bound to select any of the firms submitting bids and does not bind itself in any way to select the firm offering the lowest price. Furthermore, the contract will be awarded to the bid considered most responsive to the needs, as well as conforming to UNHCR's general principles, including economy and efficiency and best value for money.

2.8 CURRENCY AND PAYMENT TERMS FOR PURCHASE ORDERS

Any Purchase Order (PO) issued as a result of this ITB will be made in the currency of the winning offer(s). Payment will be made in accordance to the General Conditions for the Purchase of Goods and in the currency in which the PO is issued. Payments shall only be initiated after confirmation of successful completion by UNHCR business owner.

2.9 UNHCR GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACTS FOR THE PROVISION OF GOODS AND SERVICES

Please note that the General Conditions of Contracts - **Annex E** will be strictly adhered to for the purpose of any future contract. The Bidder must confirm the acceptance of these terms and conditions in writing.
