Introduction:

Monitoring and evaluation are essential to any project or program. Through this process, organizations collect and analyze data, and determine if a project/program has fulfilled its goals. As SDN JR3 is concerned in building the capacity of national NGOs through joint actions activities, partners in Khartoum agreed to have training on M&E which is an important thing during their work in implementing project activities.

Aim:

To strengthen the capacity of SDN JR Khartoum partners (NNGOs and local authorities) on M&E

Objectives:

To acquire the JR3 partners with the required knowledge and:

1. To enable SDN JR3 partner to establish M&E plan, system for their projects
2. To provide SDN JR3 partners with knowledge regarding M&E and result based management
3. To raise SDN JR partners awareness on indicators and means of verifications
4. To acquire skills on use different tools to gather data in project context

Duration:

This training can be facilitated in 5days (7hours/day including the breaks). The duration allocated for each session during this training is ranging between 1:30 hours to 2 hours according to session contents. It proposed from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

Venue:

The training proposed be held on 24th-28th October 2021

Methodology:

During the training the facilitator will used different methodology which will help him/her to facilitate the work with the participants. The following methods will be used

- Interactive lecture
- Focused group discussion/ Homework/tasks
- group work

Facilitators: the ideal numbers of facilitator to conduct this taring is two individual minimum and should be have a good experience in M&E and project management.

Participants: the suitable number of participant to be involved in the training about 20 Members (4 from each NNGO and 3 from local authorities and line ministries), to enable them to acquire knowledge and to practice all the activities get a maximum benefits.

- 6- be able to combine qualitative and quantitative approaches to gather and interpret data
