Additionally, the evaluation considers the vendor's business profile, financial health, commitment to quality and environmental standards, relevant experience, and operational capacity within designated regions. This thorough vetting process ensures that only qualified vendors who align with IOM's mission and operational needs are selected for potential collaboration.
