- 3. IOM's Code of Conduct, completed, signed and stamped.

Legal / Tax. Documents:

- 4. Business License and/or Certificate of Incorporation.
- 5. Tax Identification Number (TIN) / Tax ID Certificate.
- 6. Confirmation Letter for the BANK ACOUNT DETAILS.

Business Related Documents:

- 7. Business Description, Company Profile, Brochures and Business-Related Material.
- 8. Recent contracts/purchase orders completed (including values, delivery period and the client).
- 9. Technical capabilities relevant to IOM's requirements.
- 10. Regions/Cities covered by the supplier:
- 11. Geographical regions in which the supplier can provide services or goods in accordance with project requirements.
- 12. Capability to operate and deliver within the IOM's designated regions.

Optional / If-Applicable Requirements:

- Audited and certified financial statements for the last 3 years
- Company's environmental policy, demonstrating commitment to sustainable practices.
- Obtained quality certificates, attesting to compliance with required quality standards.
- Participation in relevant associations or industry groups. (e.g., Union of Chamber of Commerce)
- Certified copies of exclusive rights or licenses held by the company.

- All vendors that are already registered with IOM SUDAN are strongly encouraged to re-register themselves in the system to receive future invitations
- All eligible suppliers and services providers for supplies/services which are not listed above are also strongly encouraged to submit their EOI for the introduction of their business and registration.
- Suppliers must specify the areas of intervention (Location) of their activity (e.g., Northern State, Kassala State, Red Sea State etc.). Those who work in several regions/states can specify them in the submission form by indicating the address of their representation in these regions.
- Each submission will be evaluated by IOM and included in the new database depending on the results of the evaluation.
- The submission of a registration application does not guarantee automatic registration in IOM's supplier database.
- The inclusion of companies in IOM's supplier database does not mean that you will be consulted in all solicitations/RFQ/ITT issued. This only means that your company, once included in the database, will be treated equally in the company selection process in accordance with IOM's procurement procedures.
