Terms of Reference (ToR) and Scope of Work (SoW) for the Provision of Improved Seeds and storage bags in South Kordofan under BMZ Project

Project: Improved food security, livelihoods, and resilience through the promotion of peaceful coexistence among refugees, IDPs, and host communities in South Kordofan.

Activity 1.1.1 Provide agricultural inputs (improved seeds and storage bags) to 1000 HHs

1. Background: CARE International in Sudan

CARE International Sudan (CIS) has been operational in Sudan since 2009, with humanitarian, early recovery and peace building interventions. Sectors involved include Peace building, WASH, Health & Nutrition, livelihood diversification and Economic Empowerment. Through various donors funding, CARE has been providing lifesaving support and building the resilience of IDPs, refugees and vulnerable host communities in East and South Darfur, as well as South Kordofan and other states. CARE has also been supporting the urgent needs of those displaced by increasing access to safe water and sanitation facilities, developing inclusive WASH management structures, and providing an emergency nutrition response through a Community Based Management of Acute Malnutrition (CMAM) intervention for malnourished children US and pregnant and lactating women. CARE strongly supports and works with national NGOs, Community Based Organizations, government line ministries to achieve its strategies and goals in Sudan. CIS been involved actively in south Kordofan with emergency and early recovery intervention, including education, peacebuilding, WASH, Health & Nutrition, food security & livelihood projects, and balancing services between IDPs host communities, vulnerable households, and refugees in south Kordofan location. CIS committed to the technical agreements signed with the Ministry of Production and Economic Resource in south Kordofan state which confirms the close collaboration and mutual knowledge sharing CARE International in Sudan will work closely with the Ministry of Production Economic Resource relevant sectors to implement these as per the signed TA. The project effectively was running from 1st August 2023 and will end by 31st of January 2027.

BACKGROUND OF THE TASK TO BE DONE

The BMZ project intends to: (1) . 1000 vulnerable and/or women-headed households will receive agricultural inputs using agroecological practices, (2) increase crop production and productivity; (3) Seeds adapted to climatic zones (including sorghum, millet, and groundnut) are based on the needs of the farmers and distributed according to FAO guidelines for planting, saving, or exchanging.

In South Kordofan, CARE intends to procure sorghum seeds, ground nut seeds, Millets Seeds, and storage bags to support Households in Abugibiha, Gadeer , Abassiyia, and Altadamon

localities. Between 3-4 communities are targeted for support in each locality.

JUSTIFICATION FOR THIS TASK/ACTIVITY

In order to assist farmers to improve their livelihoods, CARE International will engage and mobilize farmers who have the capacity to sustainably utilize agriculture inputs in the target communities. 1000 vulnerable farmer Households (including women-headed households, youth and other community groups) who will receive improved seeds to maintain and increase crop production and productivity. Through usage of adapted seeds to climatic zones (including sorghum, millet, and groundnut) will be distributed to the farmers at designated places.

OVERALL OBJECTIVE:

To provide vulnerabilities Households with improved early maturing varieties to assist securing their livelihood and food security, and adaptive varieties to climate change.

SPECIFIC TASKS, OUTPUTS, AND TIME FRAME


- CARE will conduct a germination test, in collaboration with Agriculture Research Center (ARC) for all the listed seeds. And provision of certificate from (ARC) or available agriculture department at locality level.
- The provided seed from 2024 -2025 season production crops.
- All the seeds will be packaged as a basket on one Bag with logos (8 KG Wd Ahmed Sorghum .4KG Tabat Sorghum .5KG Groundnuts .4KG Millet)
- The contractor or the vender will responsible to submit the seeds and the inputs in communities level, in .13 communities of Abu Jubeiha; included (Alsahal,ALdelibat,Abunowra,Alserajia),Gadeer; included (HejairAldom ,ALresarsa,AljabalAlahmaer),Alabassya;icluded (Quermogia, Gerdoud Alzibil,Mahala), Altadamon; included (Alawatfa,Mubrouka,Aldapa).And CARE will be responsible for the distribution to beneficiaries in the their places.
- CARE team with consultation of communities' leader to identify a suitable distribution site in each community.
- The distribution place should be secure and accessible for all and to be nearest the Households.
- The Space will be enough to accommodate all the targeted in day of distribution (including the availability of shade, cleaning facilities, water, etc.)
