# 1. Background: CARE International in Sudan

CARE International Sudan (CIS) has been operational in Sudan since 2009, with humanitarian, early recovery and peace building interventions. Sectors involved include Peace building, WASH, Health & Nutrition, livelihood diversification and Economic Empowerment. Through various donor funding, CARE has been providing lifesaving support and building the resilience of IDPs, refugees and vulnerable host communities in East and South Darfur, as well as South Kordofan and other states. CARE received funding from the European Union to implement the Promoting Inclusive Markets and Economic Empowerment (PRIME) project in South Kordofan and East Darfur States. In South Kordofan, the project is implemented in Al-Rashad, Abujubeiha and Abbasiya localities. The project aims to contribute to sustainable and resilient livelihoods and food security in rural communities in the target states.

## BACKGROUND OF THE TASK TO BE DONE

The PRIME project intends to: (1) Sustainably increase productivity and profitability of female smallholder farmers in mango, sorghum, groundnut, and other nutrition-sensitive value chains using agroecological practices, (1) Create sustainable decent employment and income-earning opportunities for female and youth small-holder farmers through viable market linkages and value chains in rural and food insecure areas of South Kordofan and East Darfur States; (3) Increase women/youth leadership in managing community resources and sustainable access to

natural resources, contributing to food security and mitigation of conflicts over resources in South Kordofan and East Darfur States.

In South Kordofan, CARE intends to procure sorghum seeds, ground nut seeds, tools and inputs to support producer groups in Abugibiha, Rashad, and Abassiyia localities. 6groups of sorghum, comprising 180 women and 6 groups of groundnuts comprising 180 women will be supported. 3 villages are targeted for support in each locality.

With this support, CARE will sustainably increase productivity and profitability of female smallholder farmers in sorghum and groundnut value chains, create sustainable decent employment and income-earning opportunities for female and youth small-holder farmers through increased production, viable market linkages and value chains in rural and food insecure areas of Abugibiha, Rashad, and Abassiyia localities in South Kordofan state.
