Dear,

We are happy to invite you to participate in the tender for the Drilling and Installation of Water Borehole with Solar-Hybrid System– Al Bulk Hospital Omdurman.

In order to be considered eligible for the award of the contract, bidders must have completed at least two projects of comparable complexity in the last two years. Before awarding a contract, MSF may require an in person inspection of previously completed works.

MSF assesses all quotations received based on a number of objective criteria, including the proposed quotation price, estimated duration of the works, amount of experience, quality of previous work, professionalism, etc.

Our tender assessment process is transparent and neutral, ultimately endeavouring for the highest quality works.

Scope of project

The scope of this project includes the complete drilling and development of an approximately 160-meter deep water borehole at Al Bulk Hospital, Omdurman, Sudan. The contractor shall carry out a geophysical survey, drill and construct the borehole using Mild steel (0-6m) and uPVC casing and screens (06-160m), and install a 10 kW hybrid solar-powered submersible pump system. The work also includes installation of the solar array and electrical components, followed by system testing, commissioning, and on-site training.

The full specifications of the works required can be found in Annex B –BOQ and Annex C – Technical specifications.

The Contractor can propose changes to the technical specifications that improve the design according to his own experience. However, BoQ has to be filled out as provided in order to be able to compare between the different bids. Final changes to the specifications will be discussed with the winning bidder before final contract award.

Requested documents

To be considered for the above-mentioned contract we need to have received the following documents:

- A. Company fact sheet including all information requested in annex B 'terms and references'.
- B. Project list of at least 2 projects of comparable complexity in the last 2 years, including:
 - Pictures
 - Location
 - Summary of work
 - Client contact information
- C. A Bill of Quantity, describing the quantities and prices of all material and labour needed to realise the structure described in the tender package (**Annex B and C**).

- The tender process will be coordinated by international staff only. Direct contacting MSF staff, other than those mentioned above, will be a reason for disqualification.
- Only the biddings that provided all requested documents will be considered
- Biddings shall be completed in English and in metric system only;
- Biddings shall be made in Sudanese Pounds.
- All prices are including tax and other additional costs
- Winning bidder must begin with the work not later than one week after the signing of the contract;
- No costs will be paid by MSF other that those detailed in the Bill of Quantities (BOQ)
