Goods needed:

- Food items, such as drinking water, soda, dates, and refreshments
- Non-food items (NFIs), such as blankets, plastic sheets, jerry cans, ibriq, soap
- Mosquito nets,
- Office furniture
- IT equipment
- Hygiene and sanitation materials, such as waste bins, vector control spray materials and machines

Services needed:

- Rental vehicles
- Rental of trucks for Water Trucking
- Cash distribution service provider to provide cash directly to beneficiaries in communities around the Khartoum
- Consultant for providing Community Water Point Management training in Khartoum
- Consultant for providing Community WASH Volunteers training in Khartoum

Works needed:

- Construction, rehabilitation, and solarisation of water points, latrines, and streetlights
